E hiahia ana koe ki te mahi ngātahi i nga kaimahi rangatahi e kaha nei ki te whakapakari i te hunga taiohi?

Do you want to help make a difference to young people/rangatahi by supporting the people who work with them?

E hiahia ana mātou tētahi tangata ngakaunui ki te whakatinana te Rautaki Rangatahi Māori me te mahi ngātahi i Te Ara Taiohi. He whakaruruhau a motu hou a Te Ara Taiohi i whakatu ai ki te awahi te hunga tiaki rangatahi (12-24) kia whakapakari o rātou ake mahi.

We need a dynamic, dedicated person to help us implement the Taiohi Maori Strategy and be part of the Ara Taiohi team. Ara Taiohi is a new national organisation established to help people who work with young people (aged 12-24) become more connected, effective and accountable.

The person we are looking for will be passionate about the youth sector, have a can-do attitude, experienced at working at a senior level, have strong connections and relationship with iwi-based organisations and Māori service providers, and have experience in project management.

This exciting organisation builds on their two decades of experience, know-how and commitment, with support from the wider youth sector and more than 400 inaugural personal and group members.
